<b>5. Which fraction is equivalent to 16/18:</b> <b>8/9, 9/10, 6/7, 7/8 ?</b>	<b>10. Which fraction is equivalent to 6/14:</b> <b>4/9, 3/7, 5/12, 7/16 ?</b>
