5. $900000 + 80000 + 6000 + 400 + 50 + 2 [\quad] 900000 + 80000 + 7000 + 200 + 60 + 2$	10. $500000 + 30000 + 6000 + 200 + 70 + 3 [\quad] 500000 + 30000 + 2000 + 900 + 20$

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
