Description: Understand a multiple of a/b as a multiple of 1/b, and use this understanding to multiply a fraction by a whole number. For example, use a visual fraction model to express 3 x (2/5) as 6 x (1/5), recognizing this product as 6/5. (In general, n x (a/b) = (n x a)/b.).

Multiply Unit Fractions by a Whole Number:

1. 1/18 x 16 =	6. 1/19 x 18 =
2. 1/20 x 9 =	7. 1/14 x 7 =
3. 1/15 x 7 =	8. 1/8 x 7 =
4. 1/15 x 9 =	9. 1/5 x 15 =
5. 1/9 x 4 =	10. 1/20 x 2 =
