Name:**Standard: CCSS.Math.Content.4.NF.B.4.b**

Description: Understand a multiple of a/b as a multiple of $1/b$, and use this understanding to multiply a fraction by a whole number. For example, use a visual fraction model to express $3 \times (2/5)$ as $6 \times (1/5)$, recognizing this product as $6/5$. (In general, $n \times (a/b) = (n \times a)/b$.)

Multiply Unit Fractions by a Whole Number:

1. $1/4 \times 13 =$	6. $1/6 \times 14 =$
2. $1/3 \times 13 =$	7. $1/6 \times 17 =$
3. $1/13 \times 5 =$	8. $1/11 \times 2 =$
