Name:**Standard: CCSS.Math.Content.5.NF.B.7.a**

Description: Interpret division of a unit fraction by a non-zero whole number, and compute such quotients. For example, create a story context for $(1/3) \div 4$, and use a visual fraction model to show the quotient. Use the relationship between multiplication and division to explain that $(1/3) \div 4 = 1/12$ because $(1/12) \times 4 = 1/3$.

Divide Unit Fractions by a Whole Number:

1. $1/7 \div 12 =$	6. $1/16 \div 9 =$
2. $1/13 \div 7 =$	7. $1/5 \div 16 =$
3. $1/14 \div 14 =$	8. $1/13 \div 20 =$
4. $1/9 \div 4 =$	9. $1/12 \div 10 =$
5. $1/7 \div 19 =$	10. $1/4 \div 9 =$
