Description: Interpret division of a unit fraction by a non-zero whole number, and compute such quotients. For example, create a story context for (1/3) ÷ 4, and use a visual fraction model to show the quotient. Use the relationship between multiplication and division to explain that (1/3) ÷ 4 = 1/12 because (1/12) x 4 = 1/3.

Divide Unit Fractions by a Whole Number:

1. 1/15 ÷ 11 =	6. 1/13 ÷ 7 =
2. 1/11 ÷ 6 =	7. 1/17 ÷ 7 =
3. 1/8 ÷ 13 =	8. 1/16 ÷ 8 =
4. 1/4 ÷ 20 =	9. 1/20 ÷ 9 =
5. 1/4 ÷ 6 =	10. 1/13 ÷ 10 =
