Name:**Standard: CCSS.Math.Content.5.NF.B.7.b**

Description: Interpret division of a whole number by a unit fraction, and compute such quotients. For example, create a story context for $4 \div (1/5)$, and use a visual fraction model to show the quotient. Use the relationship between multiplication and division to explain that $4 \div (1/5) = 20$ because $20 \times (1/5) = 4$.

Divide a Whole Number by Unit Fractions:

1. $20 \div 1/13 =$	6. $13 \div 1/14 =$
2. $8 \div 1/6 =$	7. $9 \div 1/12 =$
3. $18 \div 1/8 =$	8. $17 \div 1/2 =$
4. $5 \div 1/5 =$	9. $6 \div 1/12 =$
5. $2 \div 1/12 =$	10. $12 \div 1/20 =$

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
