Description: Interpret division of a whole number by a unit fraction, and compute such quotients. For example, create a story context for 4 + (1/5), and use a visual fraction model to show the quotient. Use the relationship between multiplication and division to explain that $4 \div (1/5) = 20$ because $20 \times (1/5) = 4$.

Divide a Whole Number by Unit Fractions:

1. 6 ÷ 1/16 =	6. 4 ÷ 1/6 =
2. 6 ÷ 1/8 =	7. 2 ÷ 1/16 =
3. 7 ÷ 1/11 =	8. 14 ÷ 1/3 =

5. 10 ÷ 1/17 =	10. 13 ÷ 1/3 =
