Description: Write expressions that record operations with numbers and with letters standing for numbers. For example, express the calculation "Subtract y from 5" as 5 - y.

1. Write "g plus 4, or g increased by 4, or 4 more than g, or add 4 to g" as an expression:	6. Write "the quotient of w and 7, or divide w by 7" as an expression:
2. Write "the quotient of b and 5, or divide b by 5" as an expression:	7. Write "7 plus m, or 7 increased by m, or m more than 7, or add m to 7" as an expression:
3. Write "z plus 3, or z increased by 3, or 3 more than z, or add 3 to z" as an expression:	8. Write "6 minus b, or 6 decreased by b, or b less than 6, or subtract b from 6" as an expression:
4. Write "raise 10 to the u-th power" as an expression:	9. Write "the product of w and 3, or multiply w by 3" as an expression:
5. Write "the quotient of a and 9, or divide a by 9" as an expression:	10. Write "a minus 5, or a decreased by 5, or 5 less than a, or subtract 5 from a" as an expression:
