Description: Use square root and cube root symbols to represent solutions to equations of the form x<sup>2</sup> = p and x<sup>3</sup> = p, where p is a positive rational number. Evaluate square roots of small perfect squares and cube roots of small perfect cubes. Know that v2 is irrational.
